Since its inception seven years ago, the SKS Annual Fund has raised more than \$2,000,000, directly helping us close the gap in our operating budget, address deferred maintenance needs, help improve faculty salaries, and launch important new school initiatives.

This year, we were especially excited to again expand our donor base beyond our current families and raise \$380,000 demonstrating the remarkable generosity and commitment of the entire SKS community.

In addition to this outstanding achievement, the SKS Endowment Fund – established just four years ago to help secure our school's long-term future – raised an additional \$150,000 this year, bringing the SKS Endowment Fund to nearly \$1,000,000. This is a remarkable achievement in just three years! Managed by a dedicated committee of our SKS Board, the Endowment Fund serves as a critical pillar in ensuring the financial strength and sustainability of St. Katharine of Siena School for generations to come.

As someone who holds this school close to my heart, I often say that I could never fully repay all that SKS has given me. This community, this mission, and this special place have enriched my life in immeasurable ways, and SKS will always have my deepest gratitude.
