Reading Olympics is designed to promote teamwork, self-confidence, and reading for FUN! This reading enrichment program is for students in 4th and 5th grade and is optional.

Reading Olympians will work in teams to collectively read from an assigned list of 45 books during the school year. Team members will then go to the annual Delaware County Reading Olympics competition and be asked questions in a quiz-style format about the books read. Olympians will earn points for his or her team and ribbons are awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place. Reading Olympics meets once a week in the SKS library during lunch recess.
