Join us for a Math Olympiad (MOEMS) program at SKS for 4th, 5th and 6th graders. MOEMS (moems.org) is a worldwide math competition program, with over 120,000 students from every state and 39 countries participating. The objectives of MOEMS are to teach multiple strategies for outside-the-box problem solving, develop mathematical flexibility in solving those problems, and foster mathematical creativity and ingenuity through challenging competitions.

Who: 4th, 5th and 6th Graders with aptitude and/or interest in math

Duration: October – March

Additional Details:

- Students participate in five contests, November through March, taken at SKS.
- Each contest consists of five problems in 30 minutes. Students complete the contests alone; top ten student scores count towards SKS team score.
- Expectation is that one club meeting per month would be to practice review problems together (small group break-outs, and full club review), and the other meeting would be to take the contest. All contests must be taken in person at the same time.
